COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Learn how PRINCE2[®] integrates with Agile.
- Explore the PRINCE2® Agile principles, practices, and artifacts.
- Understand organizational change management and agile team roles.
- Apply agile concepts like MVP, user stories, burn charts, and planning workshops.
- Prepare confidently for the certification exam.

TARGET AUDIENCE

- Project managers, PMO members, business analysts, and agile practitioners.
- Professionals seeking to align PRINCE2® with Agile delivery practices.

COURSE CONTENT

The following elements are covered in this course:

- Agile mindset and values
- Agile estimation, MVP, and user stories
- PRINCE2® Agile principles and practices
- Agile artifacts: backlogs, dashboards, release maps
- Agile and PRINCE2® roles and responsibilities
- Agile project delivery processes
- Organizational change management

COURSE STRUCTURE

This course includes instructor-led sessions, practical exercises, and exam simulation questions

COURSE DURATION

3 days, including the final exam.

COURSE PLAN

- Day 1: Agile mindset, PRINCE2® concepts, integration with agile
- Day 2: Principles and practices, agile artifacts, people and change
- Day 3: PRINCE2® Agile processes, exam prep, and sample questions

PREREQUISITES

Delegates should have an understanding of project management but knowledge of PRINCE2® is not required.

EXAM

- Format: 40 multiple-choice questions
- Duration: 60 minutes (75 minutes if not in native language)
- Closed book
- Pass mark: 65
